The **WISC V** is the latest version of the most proven and trusted cognitive ability measure. It provides a **comprehensive picture** of a student's **cognitive abilities** including specific areas such as **memory and processing skills**.

WHAT DOES THE WISC V MEASURE?

Area	Measure	Affects
Verbal Comprehension	Understanding and using specific words.	Understanding what to do in class. Communicating ideas verbally.
Visual Spatial Skills	Organising visual information into patterns	Reading, writing and laying out of work.
Fluid Reasoning	Identifying relationship between objects.	Working independently in the classroom. Getting started and following through to the end of the task.
Working Memory	Holding onto visual and verbal information for long enough to complete a task.	Reading, writing, mental maths and following instructions.
Processing Speed	Processing what the eyes see.	Reading, writing and laying out of work

HOW DOES I-PASS USE THIS INFORMATION?

Analysis of the student's performance on the WISC V allows us to identify the **issues students may be experiencing** when engaging with lessons in the classroom.

We can then find the **solutions** faster and understand **how to support** the student with their learning.

Combining the information from the student's WISC-V performance with the WIAT-III allows for a deeper analysis which can identify specific learning difficulties such as **Dyslexia** and **Dyscalculia**.
